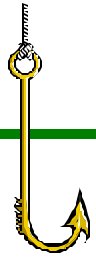

Remember, the money collected increases the chapter's general fund. Plastic drinking bottles, glass drinking

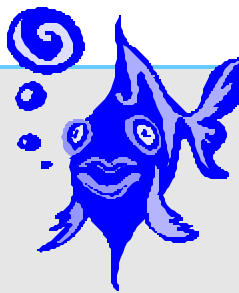
bottles, and aluminum cans are acceptable. (Not any other type of metal cans.)

We, as a chapter, have many goals to accomplish this year and your help is needed. Please plan to attend the unit

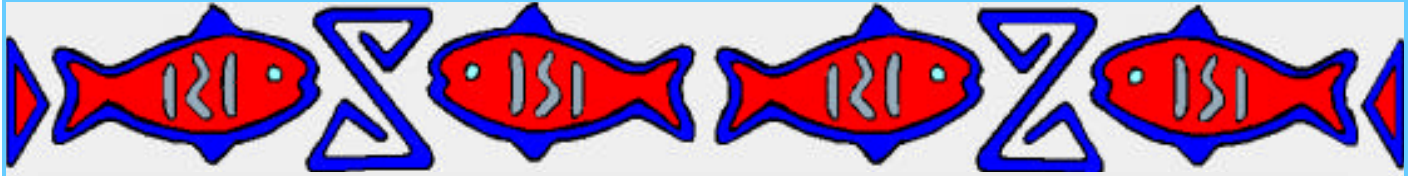
meetings (and bring a co-worker) so you will know what is happening, not only in the chapter, but on campus as well.

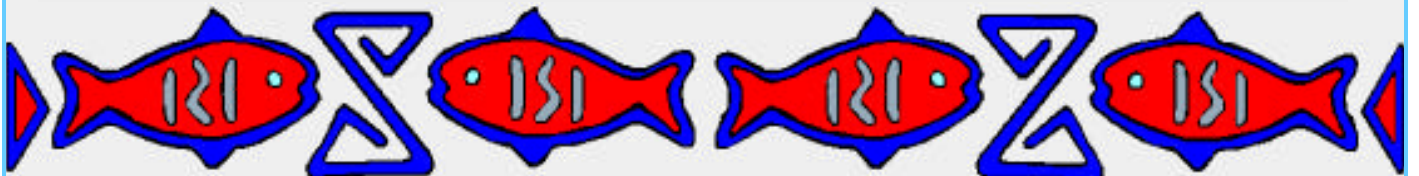


2002 - 2003 CSEA Chapter 101 Scholarship Awards
