The CSEA Scholarship Award Program provides financial assistance to deserving children of CSEA members, helping many currently enrolled in college or vocational school.

Name of Donor: CALIFORNIA SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, Chapter 608

Scholarships: Up to four (4) \$250.00 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility: Applicants for the CSEA College/Vocational Education Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

Applicants must be dependents of CSEA members in good standing.

Applicants must be enrolled on a full time basis in college/vocational school at the time application for the scholarship is made and plans to continue the term (or equivalent) immediately following receipt of scholarship.

Applicants cannot have been recipients of any other CSEA Chapter 608 scholarship or grant awards. However, if scholarship is awarded for second term of 2009 -2010 school year, recipient is eligible to apply in 2010-2011 for one (1) additional term.

Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0, including all subjects taken at the college level.

Administration

The selection of scholarship award winners and alternate is made by the CSEA Scholarship Committee.

Deadline for returning applications and required information is 5:00 p.m., May 21, 2010

The Scholarship Committee wishes to emphasize that applicants **MUST** accurately and completely provide all of the information requested on the application form. Failure to do so will be considered grounds for disqualification. Letters of recommendation 1 and 2, which accompany the application, **MUST** be used and a grade transcript **MUST** be received.

CSEA scholarships are awarded on the basis of scholarship achievement, citizenship (including character, leadership and service) and need.

The scholarship award is paid in the following manner: \$250.00 to be paid in the month of July. Before payment of scholarship award can be made, the recipient must furnish proof of his/her enrollment as specified.

It is very important to bear in mind that all CSEA scholarship applications and supporting data* must be completed and returned to Scholarship Committee Chairperson, no later than 5:00 p.m., May 21, 2010, otherwise, they will not be considered.

***Supporting data includes all letters of recommendation, transcripts, and financial statements (W-2 forms are required).**
