Community College Graduate/University Scholarship Fact Sheet

The CSEA Scholarship Award Program provides financial assistance to deserving children of CSEA Chapter 608 members, helping many currently enrolled in college or vocational school.

Name of Donor: CALIFORNIA SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, Chapter 608

Number of Scholarships: Scholarships will be in the amount of \$500 each, plus \$100 BONUS if eligible. Number given to be determined.

Eligibility: Applicants for the Community College Graduate/University Scholarship Award must meet the following requirements:

Applicants must be dependents of CSEA Chapter 608 members in good standing.

Applicants must be graduating community college students and entering an accredited four-year educational institution on a full-time basis by the term immediately following graduation or transfer.

Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5, including all subjects taken at the community college level. **BONUS** – for those applicants having a GPA of 3.0 or higher, will receive a bonus of \$100.

Administration

The selection of scholarship award winners and alternate is made by the CSEA Scholarship Committee.

Deadline for returning applications and required information is no later than 5:00 p.m., May 21, 2010.

The Scholarship Committee wishes to emphasize that applicants **MUST** accurately and completely provide all of the information requested on the application form. Failure to do so will be considered grounds for disqualification. Letters of recommendation 1 and 2, which accompany the application, **MUST** be attached, and a grade transcript **MUST** be received.

CSEA scholarships are awarded on the basis of scholarship achievement, citizenship (including character, leadership and service) and need.

The scholarship award is paid in the following manner: \$250.00 (+ \$50 if BONUS is awarded) to be paid in the month of August and \$250 (+ \$50 if BONUS is awarded) to be paid the month of January. Before payment of the first portion of the scholarship award can be made, the recipient must furnish proof of his/her enrollment as a full-time student. Before payment of the second portion of the award can be made, the recipient must verify his/her continuous enrollment in the previous session, as well as enrollment for the following session. If the recipient of an award fails to complete the first session, all remaining monies will be forfeited and awarded to a designated alternate.

It is very important to bear in mind that all CSEA Chapter 608 scholarship applications and supporting data* must be completed and returned to Scholarship Committee Chairperson, no later than 5:00 p.m., May 21, 2010 otherwise, they will not be considered.

***Supporting data includes all letters of recommendation, transcripts, and financial statements (W-2 forms are required)**
