DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Canvassers will:

- Demonstrate knowledge of current economic and labor issues at the local, state, and national levels
- Communicate and engage with the public about economic issues
- Register voters and affiliate community members
- Follow all safety policies and standards of the organization
- Maintain data and track results using systems provided
- Document community interaction results
- Attend meetings and events as required
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be physically able to stand and walk outside for several hours at a time. All candidates must be dependable with a proven ability to interact face to face with diverse community members. Driver's license, proof of insurance and reliable personal vehicle is desired.

Bilingual skills including English, Spanish, Tagalog, Vietnamese, or another language, strongly preferred. Existing knowledge of labor movement or economic issues, community organizing or canvassing experience is preferred. A background check is required.

PAY AND BENEFITS:

This is a temporary, short-term position with no paid benefits. The hourly pay rate is \$14.00 per hour. The canvasser schedule is 20-30 hours per week during afternoons, evenings and weekends. The position requires a flexible schedule to meet community needs.
