The Governor has declared a state of emergency in the Southern California counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and Santa Barbara; thereby initiating the availability of relief funds for California School Employees Association members/staff from the **Dorothy Bjork Assistance Fund**.

■ **Emergency Assistance**—Provides immediate emergency funds for temporary housing, clothing, food, etc. to eligible CSEA members and staff whose primary place of residence is uninhabitable as a result of the disaster. Applicants' primary place of residence must be deemed uninhabitable and partially or temporarily condemned by an official agency (such as Fire, Police and/or Building Departments). The maximum assistance under this program is \$1,000 per applicant.

■ **Disaster Assistance**—Provides assistance to eligible members and staff for uninsured loss as a result of the declared disaster. "Loss" means loss of real or personal property only, the replacement costs of which are not covered by insurance or not reimbursable from other sources. "Loss" does not include loss of income or personal or bodily injury. Applicants must have suffered a minimum net loss of \$2,500.

Members may be eligible for both programs. Please contact your local CSEA field office or CSEA Headquarters (800-632-2128) for applications and more information.
